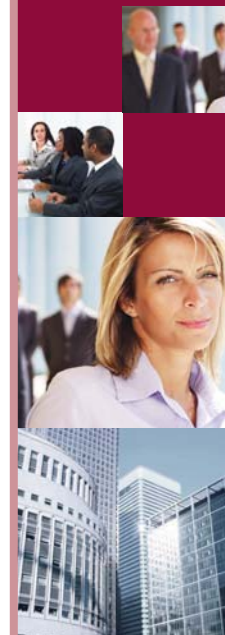

Who will benefit?

How do I study for the course?

What qualification do I gain?

Once you have satisfactorily completed your studies, and achieved passes in all five sections, you will be awarded the Diploma in Security Management, and you will be invited to the annual Presentation Ceremony to receive your certificate. Students are also eligible to submit an entry for the prestigious annual Wilf Knight Award for innovation in security management.

Diploma Programme

Modules

Assessment is by course work which is marked and returned as the course progresses.

Enrolment takes place throughout the year, with the course commencing three times each year.
