The **Security Institute** promotes the highest standards of professionalism and integrity amongst its members.

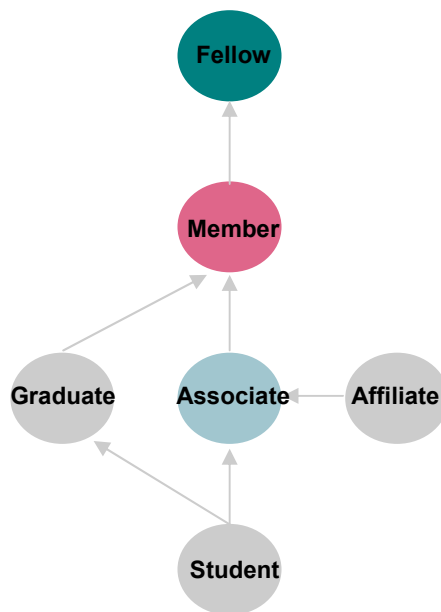

Security Institute membership is for the person, not company, and is open to everyone working in a security management position, including security systems and service providers, academics and trainers, end users, security consultants, across the public and private sector, subject to vetting.

All applications are reviewed by the Validation Board, who award points for qualifications, training, work experience and other contributions you have made to the security profession.

Associates score between 11 and 20 points. This grade shows you are serious about your career in security, although you may be relatively new to the profession. **Members** score between 21 and 60 points. They are skilled security professionals, who have a wealth of experience and/or qualifications. **Fellows** are at the peak of their security career, and must demonstrate academic achievement as well as practical application.

Mentoring Programme

The **Security Institute** mentoring programme provides career support and practical 'on-the-job' feedback to both members and prospective members who are developing their careers in the security profession.
